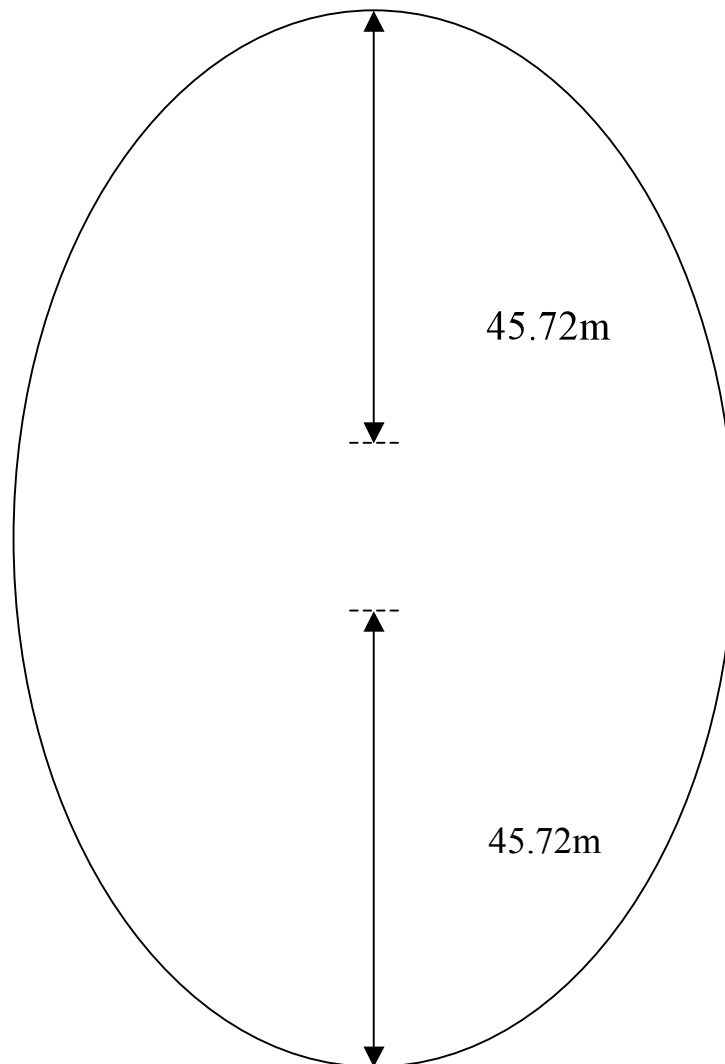
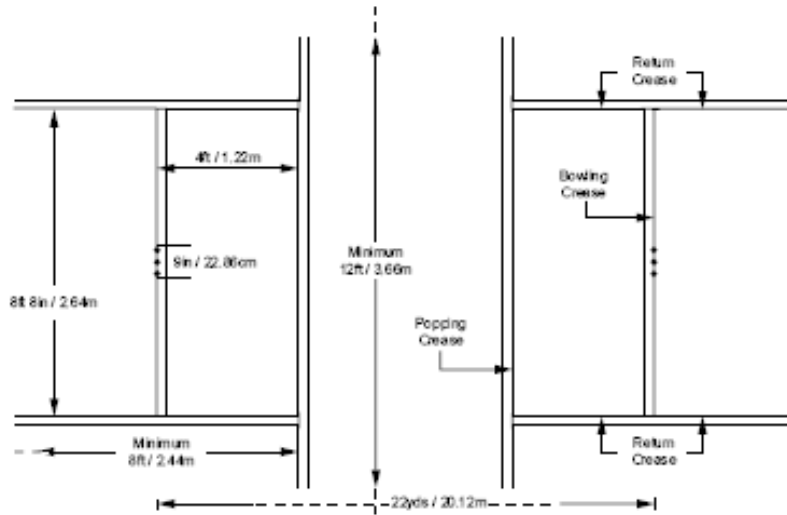




# Cricket

## Cricket

**Pitch Area:** - The wicket is 1.52m (1.64yds) in width on either side of a line joining the centre of the middle stumps of the wicket, 20.12m (22yds). The Boundary can be any size but must be a minimum of 45.72m (50yds) from middle stumps and each end of the wicket.

**Synthetic Pitch Area:** - Minimum of 17.68m (19.33yds) and 1.83m (2yds) in width.

**Bowling Crease:** - The bowling crease is marked inline with the stumps at each end, this will be 2.64m (2.89yds) in length with the stumps in the centre.

**Popping Crease (Box):**- This runs parallel to and is in front of the bowling crease. The back edge of the crease is 1.22m (1.33yds) from the centre stumps. It extends to a minimum of 1.83m (2yds) on either side of the line of the wicket and is considered to be unlimited in length.

**Return Crease:** - The inside edge is the crease. It measures 1.22m (1.33yds) minimum behind the wicket and is at right angles with both ends of the bowling crease. A forward extension is marked to meet the popping crease. It also is considered to be unlimited in length.

**Wicket:** - the wickets are 20.12m (22yds) apart. Each wicket is 711mm (28in) high, 228.6mm (9in) wide and comprises of three wooden stumps. Two wooden bails are placed on top of the stumps and are not more than 13mm (½in) above them and are 111mm (4.33in) in length.

### **Junior Cricket:** -

In junior cricket, the same definitions of the wickets shall apply subject to the following measurements being used.

Width: -	8 in/20.32cm
Pitched for under 13:-	21 yards/19.20m
Pitched for under 11:-	20 yards/18.29m
Pitched for under 9:-	18 yards/16.46m
Height above playing surface: -	27 in/68.58cm

**Lines:** - All lines are white, and 2.5cm (1in) wide.
